There will be no action taken by the Board at these two town hall meetings

The public, all interested parties, and stakeholders are invited to present information and offer comments relative to consumer protection and other issues associated with the use of the “Southern California stipulation.” The Board welcomes members of the judiciary, attorneys, and licensees to attend and present information and/or concerns they may have.
